The Northern Arts Council (NAC) was formed in 1969 for the purpose of developing and sponsoring art and cultural events in Northern Wisconsin and is the longest continuing local arts group in the state. We have supported a wide variety of worthy programs, including dance and choral groups, as well as adult authors and children's programs.

The NAC Finance Committee will soon prepare the budget for the coming year and invites you to fill out and submit the included funding application. The NAC awards grants to non-profit groups based on available funds. NAC grants range from \$100 to \$5000. The deadline for completed applications is December 1st.
